

LIST OF POTENETIAL PROJECTS:

- 1. Debris Cleanup. Rent a 40 yard dumpster to dispose of debris. \$500 -\$1000 depending on how many tons of garbage.
- 2. Bathroom Upgrade. Update sinks, toilets, doors, floors, and paint in each bathroom. This would include removing and rebuilding the handicap ramp for the women's restroom. \$1,000 \$2,000 for repairs.
- 3. Sanctuary Floor. Use appropriate tile from available tile around the facility to replace carpet in sanctuary if possible. \$500 \$1,000 depending on whether we can use the tile we already have available.
- 4. Minor Upgrades in Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall. Electrical, Walls, etc. Cost is TBD.
- 5. Sanctuary Entrance and Awning. Make the necessary repairs to the awning (replace warped and rotting wood) Replace or re-finish front sanctuary doors. \$1,000 \$2,000.
- 6. Sign. Purchase and replace current vinyl banner to reflect current church. \$200 \$400.
- 7. Paint. Re-paint the entire outside of the sanctuary and fellowship hall. \$750 \$1,500.
- 8. Roof/Rafters/Fascia/Soffit on Sanctuary.

 Need expert opinions but this would cost anywhere between \$5,000 \$15,000.
